PRECAST WAGE & BENEFIT PACKAGE

To all contractors who employ Ironworkers in the jurisdiction of **Ironworkers Local Union #498**:
Please be advised that effective **June 1, 2021 through May 31, 2022**, wage rates will be as follows:

Hourly wage for:	Regular	Time and a half	Double Time
Journeyman	\$37.23	\$55.85	\$74.46
Foreman with 2 men or less	\$39.84	\$59.75	\$79.67
Foreman with 3 men or more	\$41.70	\$62.55	\$83.40
General Foreman	\$43.56	\$65.34	\$87.12

The guidelines for overtime pay are based on the “Precast Package – Addendum “B” to the Collective Bargaining Agreement for Ironworkers Local 498.
